AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT NOISE, DISTURBANCE AND DISORDERLY ASSEMBLAGE OR CONDUCT IN THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD AND PROVIDING FOR ARREST AND PUNISHMENT OF PERSONS GUILTY OF THE SAME

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section I. Disorderly Conduct.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, within the limits of the Town of Grey Cloud to disturb the peace and quiet of any street, neighborhood, family of persons; any meeting of persons for a lawful purpose or any public place or commercial establishment, by singing, shouting, screaming, obscene or profane language or conversation; by swearing, quarreling, scolding, cursing, challenging, assaulting, or offensive or indecent language or by any device or pretense whatever.

Section II. Interference with Person.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the limits of the Town of Grey Cloud, to annoy or interfere with any person or persons whether on the streets and public ways, in a private residence, or in a public place or commercial establishment by any offensive or disorderly act or language.

Section III. Interference with use of Streets and Public Places. It shall be unlawful for any persons or persons, within the limits of the Town of Grey Cloud to loiter upon the streets and public ways of said Town or in any public place or commercial establishment in such a manner as to cause annoyance or interference with the use of such streets and public ways or the operation of any public place or commercial establishment.

Section IV. Penalty.

Any person or persons who violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days.

Section V. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
