

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD; AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA DOES ORDAIN:

Section I. Regulation of Operation.

Except for Sections 169.02, 169.04, 169.10, 169.11, 169.66, 169.78, 169.965, 169.98, Minnesota Statutes 1957, Chapter 169, known as the Highway Traffic Regulation Act as amended by Laws 1959 CC. 62, 66, 96, 215, 255, 276, 277, 410, 439, 521 and 679; Laws 1961, Reg. Sess., CC. 16, 29, 31, 34, 48, 65, 209 and 454; and Laws 1961, Ex. Sess. C. 19, is hereby adopted as the Traffic Regulation Ordinance of the Town of Grey Cloud, Washington County, Minnesota. Every Provision contained in said statute is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section II. Scope.

- A. The provisions of this ordinance relating to operation of vehicles refer to streets and highways within the Town of Grey Cloud, Washington County, Minnesota.
- B. It is unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person to do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required in this ordinance.
- C. No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of any peace officer invested by law with authority to direct, control or regulate traffic.

Section III. Penalties.

Any person who shall do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required in this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days.

Section IV. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
