OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE AND PERSONAL WATERCRAFT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE AND OPERATION OF ALL OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES INCLUDING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, OFF-HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLES, AND OFF-ROAD VEHICLES AND PERSONAL WATERCRAFT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GREY CLOUD.

SECTION I. ADOPTION BY REFERENCE

All existing regulations for such motorized vehicles in effect for the State of Minnesota Agencies and by Washington County. These regulations are made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION II. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

- A. Place of Operation. Off-road vehicles may be operated on the extreme right side of all township roads in compliance with current Minnesota State regulations. It shall be unlawful to operate any of the above vehicles in any of the following places or conditions:
 - 1. Upon private property without written or oral permission of the owner or person entitled to possession and use of said property.
 - 2. Upon Township property, parks or recreational areas unless authorized by Town Officials.
 - 3. Within ditches of township roads.
- B. Hours of Operation on Public Roads
 It shall be lawful to operate the above vehicles within the Township of Grey
 Cloud, only between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. on Sundays through
 Thursdays, and only between 7:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. on Fridays and
 Saturdays.

SECTION III. PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
